Overview

Ferry Conservation District is sponsoring its annual Spring Conservation Fair poster contest. This year, all ages and levels of expertise are encouraged to enter. The Spring Conservation Fair celebrates the natural and community resources found around our Ferry County community. There will be workshops, handouts, activities for kids, a plant sale pick-up, concessions, and more! This year's fair will be April 26, 2025. This year also marks the 28th Annual Conservation Fair and 50th Annual Plant Sale!

Prize	The winner's design will be displayed as Conservation Fair propaganda all over Ferry County and on a button to be handed out at the fair.
Deadline	Jan 23, 2025
General Information	All entries must be clearly identified (on the reverse side if hand-delivered) with the attached entry form.
Eligibility	Everyone is eligible to enter the poster contest. There is no age limit for contestants. All ages and levels of expertise are encouraged to enter!

Project Specifics

Entry Specifications	<p>Image size of entry must be approximately 8.5" x 11" vertical or horizontal. Contestants have two options to choose from for their entry. Art in either option must be finished artwork. Please be aware that the winning entry cannot feature items such as cigarettes or weapons that are NOT allowed at the Spring Conservation Fair.</p> <p>Each participant is allowed a maximum of three entries. (please don't send same poster repeatedly)</p>

Design Options	<p>Contestants have two options to choose from for their entry:</p> <p>OPTION #1: An illustration in your choice of media (pencil, pen, colored pencils, markers, crayons, or paint) and should include one of the themes of agriculture/conservation/nature/outdoors/community. For those familiar with the usage of type, you may include the words "Conservation Fair `25" OR "2025 Spring Conservation Fair", OR "2025 Conservation Fair," OR "Ferry Conservation Fair 2025", "April 25th, "Ferry County Fairgrounds."</p> <p>OPTION #2: An illustration in your choice of media <i>excluding</i> the type in Option #1. The artwork does not need to have a reserved space for the type. The Ferry Conservation District will apply those type elements.</p>
Entry Options	<p>Digital entries are preferred but hand delivered entries will be accepted at 84 E. Notification	<p>The Ferry Conservation District Board of Supervisors will jury the entries at their regular February meeting. The winning artist will be notified between February 27th - March 7th 2025, and announced on our website and social media after notification. Non-winning artists are not guaranteed to receive notification and will not be provided any feedback on their entry.</p>
Non-Winning Entries	<p>Non-winning, hand-delivered entries may be picked up after March 15th, 2025, at the Ferry Conservation District Office, 84 E. Delaware Ave. Republic WA. The Ferry Conservation District will not be responsible for entries that are incomplete, lost, delivered late, "postage-due," misdirected or illegible. All submissions will become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned; however, they can be collected by the artist after March 15th, 2025. By entering, you agree to receive e-mails from Sponsor / Administrator or those directed by Sponsor / Administrator. Entrants acknowledge and agree that Sponsor and Administrator shall have the right to edit, adapt, modify, reproduce, publish, promote, create a sound recording of, broadcast, or otherwise display or use entries in any way it sees fit without limitation or compensation to entrants.</p> <p>No entries will be stored after April 1, 2025</p>
